Introduction.— Due to rise in vehicular population the increasing number of accidents is a matter of concern. Moreover, violations of traffic laws in the State are also increasing and it is not feasible to detail traffic staff of the Police Department at each and every corner due to limited manpower resources. Therefore to enable and encourage citizens to participate and assist the Traffic Police, it is proposed to start a "Traffic Sentinel Scheme".

2. Short title and commencement.— (1) This scheme may be called the "Goa Traffic Sentinel Scheme, 2017".

(2) It shall be deemed to have come in force w.e.f. 10th November, 2017.

3. Aims & Objective.— As a part of community policing active participation of members of public through Traffic Sentinel Scheme will be sought to prosecute traffic violators. This scheme will also play a major role in creating road safety awareness amongst various sections of road users and will assist the Traffic police to prosecute traffic violators, create traffic sense amongst various sections of road users, by seeking active participation of members of public.

4. Type of violations and their reward points.—

5. Working of Traffic sentinel scheme.— (i) Members of public will have to register themselves through "WhatsApp" a freeware and (cross-platform messaging and voice over IP Service) No. 7875756110 by providing their Full Name and Mobile Number.

(ii) The Mobile Number itself will be the Unique Identity (UID).

(iii) Thereafter while reporting any violation the UID should always be mentioned so as to credit the rewards points to the UID.

(iv) The violation shall be reported on WhatsApp No. 7875756110.

(v) Once a citizen collects 100 points, he/she will be given cash reward of Rs. 1,000/-, after deduction of statutory taxes/charges (as applicable).

(vi) The cash reward shall be debited from the Budget Head: Demand No. 17, 3055—Road Transport; 00; 004—Traffic Sentinel Scheme; 01—Road Safety Education & Training (P); 50—Other Charges.

(vii) The Traffic Sentinel Scheme will be automated by developing a 'Mobile Application' ("App") for reporting of violations by the Traffic Sentinels and 'Web Application' for management of Scheme in the due course.

(viii) Once the App is made operational, it will be available on "Play Store" (a digital distribution service operated and developed by Google) and the WhatsApp Number shall cease to be operational.

(ix) All Traffic Sentinels enrolled under the scheme shall download the "App" from the "Play Store" and upload the violations noticed by them through the App.

(x) Terms and conditions relating to eligibility, responsibilities of the Traffic Sentinels will be issued through a Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) to be formulated by Police Department and the same shall be binding on all Traffic Sentinels. This SOP shall be uploaded on "WhatsApp"/"App" as the case may be.

6. The Traffic Sentinel Scheme shall be operated and maintained by an officer not below the rank of Police Sub-Inspector. He/She shall be assisted by adequate number of subordinate staff. Dy. Supdt. of Police Traffic (HQ) shall be the Supervisory Officer under the overall supervision of Superintendent of Police (Traffic).

7. The Government shall have the power to relax any or all clauses or conditions of the scheme.

8. If any question arises regarding interpretation of any clause, word, expression of the scheme, the decision shall vest with the Government and the same shall be final and binding on all concerned.
