- 2. The candidates have been allotted Seat Numbers for appearing the Written Examination which is mentioned against the Application Numbers above. Also the Seat Number and Examination Centre have been mentioned on the Call Letter sent to them through the Post.

The Written Examination shall be of 100 marks for 02 hours duration on the subjects (1) Vehicle rules and regulations (2) Motor Vehicle Act (3) Vehicle Mechanisms:- (a) Working of Petrol Engine (b) Working of Diesel Engine (c) Working of Clutch (d) Working of Gear Box (e) Working of Transmission system (f) Working of Differential and Final Drive (g) Working of vehicle AC (h) Working of Engine Cooling system (i) Working of Engine Lubrication system (j) Working of Steering system (k) Working of Breaking system (l) Working of Electrical system, Starter Motor, Alternator and Battery (4) Responsibilities and duties of driver (5) Road Signals, Traffic Signals and General RTO Rules (6) General Maintenance practices for vehicles.
- 4. The candidates shall carry with them the Call Letter and one of the photo identification proof in original to answer the Written Examination. The candidate is required to occupy the seat 01 hour before the scheduled time. The electronic devices including Cellphones, Cameras, Calculators etc. will not be allowed in the Examination Hall.
