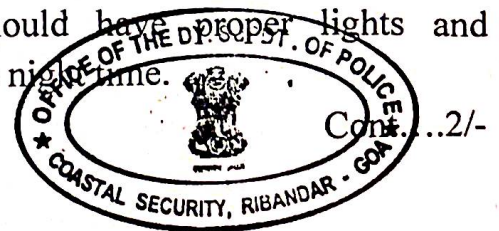
PUBLIC NOTICE

Sub:- Regarding Invitation of Bids for supply of 05 private fishing trawlers / private launches for Sagar Kavach (Goa)-01/26.

Sealed Quotation is hereby invited for supply of total 05 nos. of fishing trawlers / private launches for the Coastal Security Exercise "Sagar Kavach (Goa) 01/26" scheduled on 23rd & 24th April, 2026. The bids should reach to the Office of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Coastal Security, Ribandar on or before 12.00 hrs. of 17.04.2026.

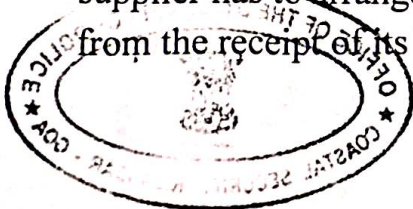
Terms and conditions are as follows:

1. The length of the fishing trawler / private launch shall be at least 12 mts.
2. A single vendor should supply min. of 2 nos. or more fishing trawler / private launches.
3. The fishing trawlers / private launches should be equipped with communication, and safety equipments such as VHF, GPS, lifejackets and life buoys, extinguisher, etc.
4. The fishing trawlers / private launches should have onboard crew for the safe operation of the said boats as mandated by the Registering Authority.
5. The fishing trawlers / private launches should be seaworthy and should be in good condition.
6. The fishing trawler / private launches should carry sufficient amount of diesel / fuel to venture out at sea, ration for onboard crew members and water to cater the basic needs of the crew members during the exercise.
7. The fishing trawlers / private launches should have proper lights and navigational signals so as to ply even during the night time.

8. The fishing trawler / private launches shall be registered under appropriate Act and should possess Valid Registration Certificate and Licence, certificates and other mandated documents by the Registration Authority.
9. All the crew members boarding the vessel should mandatorily carry QR coded Aadhaar card or any Photo Identity Proof issued by the Government Authority.
10. The fishing trawler / private launches should be given at the disposal of Coastal Security Police for further necessary communication and instructions.
11. The Tandel / Captain / crew members of the fishing trawlers / private launches shall strictly follow the instruction given by Coastal Security Police during the exercise from time to time.
12. The quoted amount should include the rate of all charges including hiring of the fishing trawler / private launches, diesel, crew members including taxes (if any) etc.
13. GST/taxes, if any to be indicated separately.
14. The fishing trawlers / private launches will have to be insured by the supplier at his own cost to ensure safe operations. The Department will not be responsible for the damage cause during the exercise.
15. The fishing trawlers / private launches supplied will be finally accepted only after the inspection by the competent authority or appointed by the Superintendent of Police, Coastal Security whose decision in this regards will be final.
16. The supplied fishing trawlers / private launches shall be deployed to patrol along the coast of Goa, operating from rivers of Chapora, Mandovi, Zuari, Sal and Talpona.
17. The supplied fishing trawlers / private launches for the said exercise shall be utilized to patrol commencing from 23.04.2026 at 05.00 hrs. and likely to terminate on 24.04.2026 at 19.00 hrs.
18. The supplied fishing trawlers / private launches will be required to be provided at the designated Coastal Security Police Station on 22.04.2026 at 16.00 hrs.
19. In the event of any fishing trawler / private launch reporting break down, the supplier has to arrange alternate fishing trawler / private launch within one hour from the receipt of its notification.

20. The payment towards the supply made will be done after submission of the bill in triplicate duly affixed with revenue stamp by the supplier.
21. The Superintendent of Police, Coastal Security or designated Officer by him reserves the right to negotiate the rate if the fishing trawler / private launches are found proper as per the specifications.
22. The Superintendent of Police, Coastal Security reserves the right to accept or reject the quotation without assigning any reason thereof.
